Technical Equipment: Robert Jones reported that the quality and quantity of POPS tools has been reduced due to breakage and disappearance. He proposed that he would do an inventory of tools at the end of Aladdin, Jr. Subsequent directors/producers would be responsible for maintaining the inventory and replacing tools that are broken or disappear. It was approved that Robert purchase the items that are a priority and the treasurer will take a look at the books and let us know at a subsequent meeting what funds are available.

Headsets: Gary Hughes requested \$100 to purchase new headsets. Some members expressed a preference to buy their own. It was approved to allot \$100 for the purchase of new headsets.

Bank Bag: Abbey Bertelone requested \$14.95 to purchase a new bank bag. It was approved.
